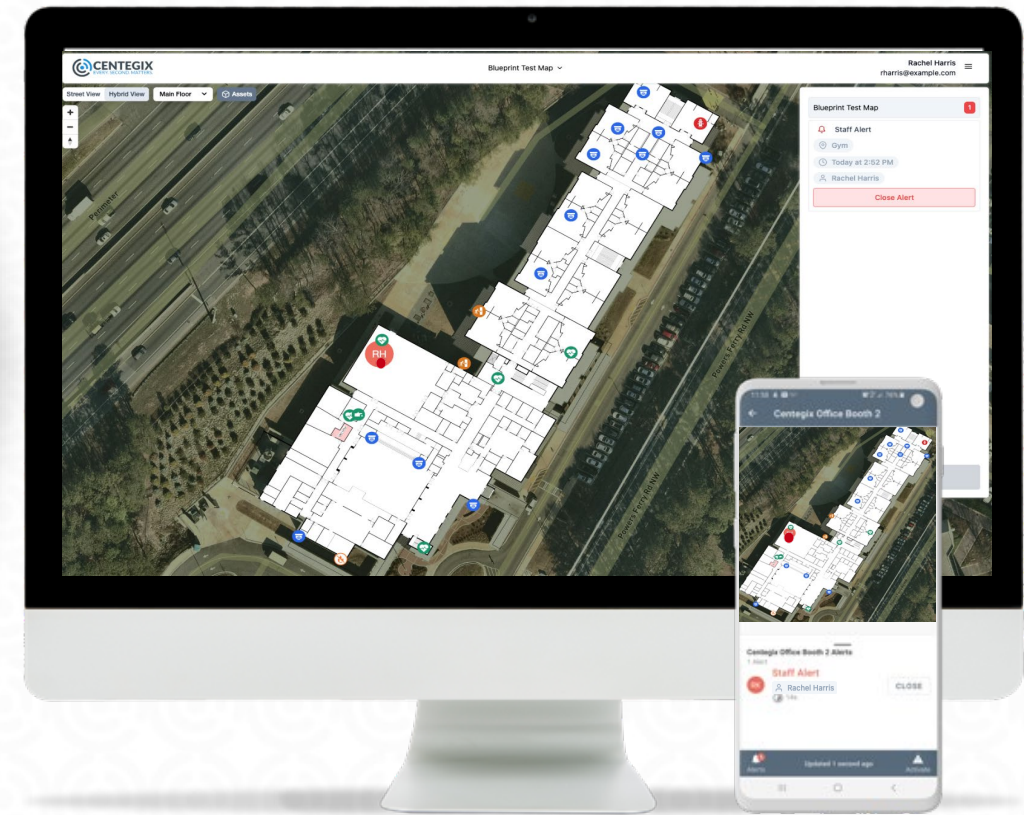

1st Responder Location & Live Maps







After The Alert:

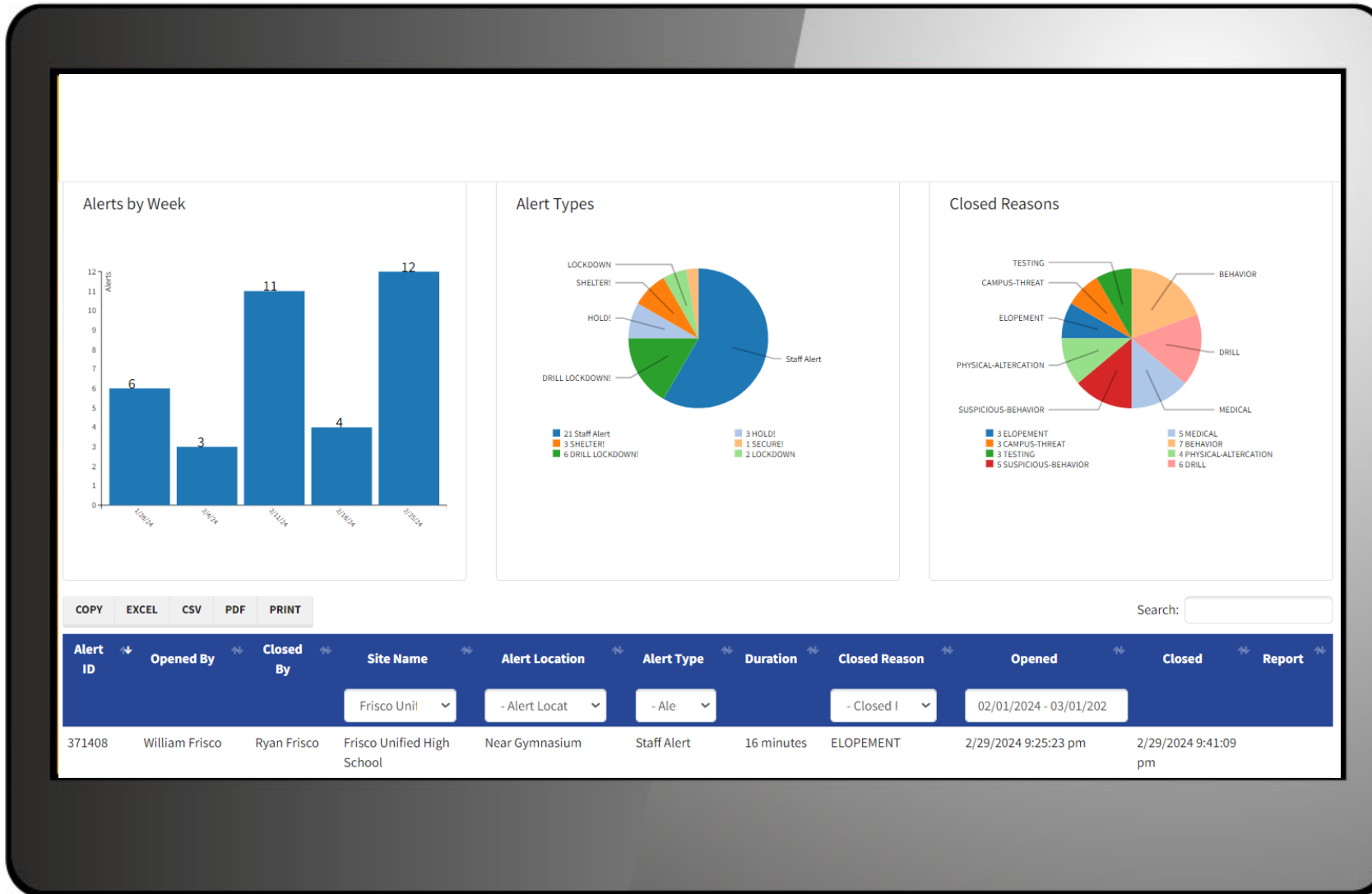
- The responding administrator closes the alert
