## Policy 5113.1: Chronic Absence And Truancy

Original Adopted Date: 01/13/2009 | Last Revised Date: 10/16/2018 | Last Reviewed Date: 10/16/2018

The Governing Board believes that absenteeism, whatever the cause, may be an early warning sign of poor academic achievement and may put students at risk of dropping out of school. The Board desires to ensure that all students attend school in accordance with the state's compulsory education law and take full advantage of educational opportunities provided by the district.

The Superintendent or designee shall establish a system to accurately track student attendance in order to identify individual students who are chronic absentees and truants, as defined in law and administrative regulation, and to identify patterns of absence throughout the district. He/she shall provide the Board

The Superintendent, attendance supervisor, or designee shall consult with data onstudents, parents/guardians, school attendance, staff, and community agencies, as appropriate, to identify factors contributing to chronic absence, and truancy-rates districtwide, for each school, and disaggregated for each numerically significant student subgroup as defined in Education Code 52052. Such data shall be used in the development of annual goals and specific actions for student.

The Superintendent, attendance and engagement to be included in the district's local control and accountability plan and other applicable school and district plans.

The Superintendentsupervisor, or designee shall develop a tiered approach to reducing chronic absence. Such an approach shall include strategies that focus on prevention offor preventing attendance problems, which may include, but are not limited to, efforts to provide a safe and positive school environment, relevant and engaging learning experiences, school activities that help develop students' feelings of connectedness with the school, school-based health-services services, letters alerting parents/guardians to the value of regular school attendance, and incentives and rewards to recognize students who achieve excellent attendance or demonstrate significant improvement in attendance.-

The Superintendent or designee also tiered approach shall develop strategies that enablealso provide for early outreach to students as soon as they show signs of poor attendance.

The Superintendent or designee shall consult with students, parents/guardians, or if they were chronically absent in the prior school staffyear. Early intervention may include personalized outreach, individual attendance plans, and community agencies, as appropriate,/or mentoring to identify factors contributing to students with moderate levels of chronic absence and truancy.

Interventions, with additional intensive, interagency wrap-around services for students with the highest level of absence.

Students with serious attendance problems shall be designed to meet the provided with interventions specific to their needs of the student and, which may include, but are not limited to, health care referrals, transportation assistance, counseling for mental or emotional difficulties, academic supports, efforts to address school or community safety concerns, discussions with the student and parent/guardian about their attitudes regarding schooling, or other strategies to remove identified barriers to school attendance. The Superintendent, attendance supervisor, or designee may collaborate with child welfare services, law enforcement, courts, public health care agencies, other government agencies, and/or medical, mental health, and oral health care providers to make alternative educational programs and support services available for students and families.

As required by law, habitually truant students shall be referred

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that staff assigned to a school fulfill attendance review board (SARB), a truancy mediation program operated by-related duties are trained in implementing a trauma-informed approach to chronic absence and receive information about the county's district attorney or probation officer, and/or a juvenile court.

high correlation between chronic absence and exposure to adverse childhood experiences.

Students who are identified as chronically absent or truant shall be subject to the interventions specified in law and administrative regulation.

A student's truancy, tardiness, or other absence from school shall not be the basis for his/her-suspension or expulsion. Alternative strategies and positive reinforcement for attendance shall be used whenever possible. The Superintendent, attendance supervisor, or designee shall periodically report to the Board regarding the district's progress in improving student attendance patterns in the district, including rates for all students of chronic absence and truancy districtwide and for each school, grade level, and numerically significant student populationsubgroup as defined in Education Code 52052. Such information shall be used to evaluate the effectiveness of strategies implemented to reduce chronic absence and truancy and to make changes as needed, develop annual goals and specific actions for student attendance and engagement to be included in the district's local control and accountability plan and other applicable school and district plans. As appropriate, the Superintendent or designee shall engage school staff in program evaluation and improvement and in the determination of how to best allocate available community resources.
