Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP)

What is it?

ELOP provides funding for afterschool and summer school enrichment programs for tk through sixth grade.



ELOP

What is it offered?

“Expanded learning” means before school, after school, summer, or intersession learning programs that focus on developing the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests of pupils through hands-on, engaging learning experiences.



ELOP Specifications

- No less than 9 hours of program includes school day
- Components of the day can be provided before and/or after school
- All school days + 30 intersession days
- Locations of program must be on all elementary sites



ELOP Elements

- Educational and literacy element in which tutoring or homework assistance is provided
- Educational Enrichment
- Encouraged to collaborate with community based organizations
