Truancy Vs. Chronic Absence

TRUANCY

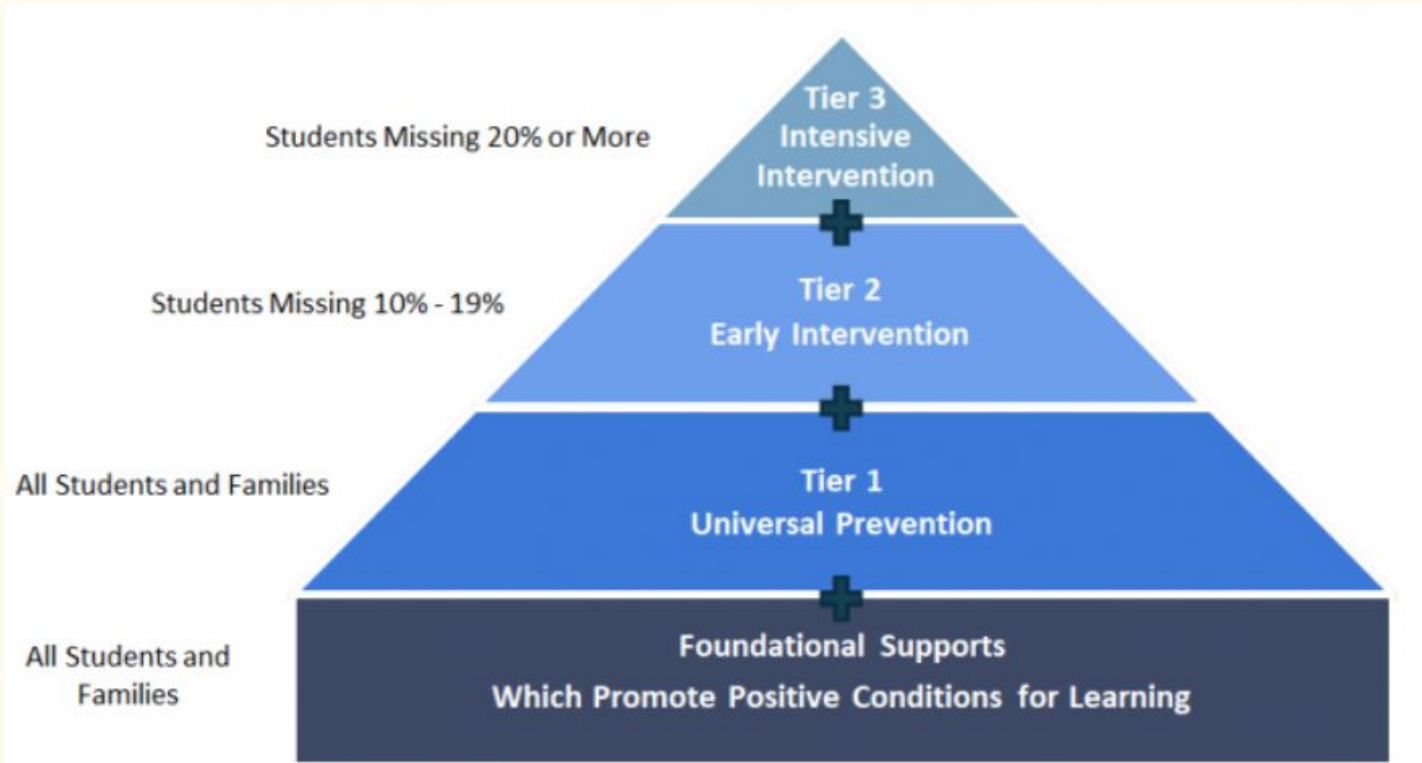
- Counts only unexcused absences
- Emphasizes compliance with school rules
- Relies on legal & administrative solutions

Vs.

CHRONIC ABSENCE

- Counts all absences: excused, unexcused & suspensions
- Emphasizes academic impact of missed days
- Uses community-based, positive strategies





Tier 1 Universal Supports

- Clear, concise and consistent communication about schedules and expectations
- Connection to a caring adult in the school
- Impact of attendance on whole child
- Personalized positive communication
- Positive environment
- Routines and celebrations related to attendance and engagement
- Recognition of good and improved attendance

Tier 2 Early Intervention

- Attendance monitoring
- Check-In/Check-Out
- Common barriers identified
- Expanded learning opportunities
- Home visits
- Restorative alternatives to discipline and suspension
- Site interventions and Aeries monitoring
- Small group interventions and supports for students

Tier 3 Intensive Intervention

- Housing or other stability support if needed
- Legal intervention
- Refer family to additional services
- Student Success Team
- Student Attendance Review Board
