

Bylaw 9330.1: ^Membership In Associations/Organizations

In general, it shall be the intention of the Governing Board to ally itself to those professional organizations of the County, State, and Nation which exist for the purpose of supporting and advancing public education. Board membership, however, will be limited to those professional organizations acknowledged by the state legislature, or by the state Department of Education, as "approved for membership."

It is in the policy of this Board to encourage the attendance of individual Board membership at a reasonable number of the county, area, state, and national meetings and conventions which are held from time to time. The association with other representative Board Members and educators, and the knowledge and information gained by Members of this Board at such meetings and conventions has, in the past years, proven of genuine value. It is particularly the desire of the Board that it be represented by one or more of its members at the annual conventions of the National School Boards Association.

The Board also encourages the attendance of the Superintendent and the Assistant Superintendents at a reasonable number of the meeting and conventions of appropriate professional organizations with which they are expected to ally themselves as a part of their personal responsibilities for continued professional growth.

Membership of individual members of the Board, and of the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendents, in civic and service organizations, is encouraged.
