## **Regulation 3260: Fees And Charges**

Charge when When approved by the Governing Board, the Superintendent or designee may impose a fee for the following:\_ (5 CCR-\_350)

- 1. Insurance for athletic team members, with an exemption providing for the district to pay the cost of the insurance for any team member who is financially unable to pay (Education Code-32221)
- 2. Insurance for medical or hospital service for students participating in field trips and excursions\_ (Education Code-35331)
- 3. Expenses of students' participation in a field trip or excursion within the state or to another state, the District of Columbia, or a foreign country, as long as no student is prohibited from making the field trip due to lack of funds\_ (Education Code-35330)
- 4. Student fingerprinting program, as long as the fee does not exceed the actual costs associated with the program\_ (Education Code-32390)
- 5. School camp programs in outdoor science education, conservation education, or forestry operated pursuant to Education Code-\_8760-8774, provided that the fee is not mandatory and no student is denied the opportunity to participate for nonpayment of the fee\_ (Education Code-\_35335)
- Reimbursement to the district for the direct cost of materials providedused by the district a student for the fabrication of nonperishable personalstudents to fabricate property the studentthey will take home for his/hertheir own possession and use, such as wood shop, art, or sewing projects kept by the studentstudents (Education Code-17551)
- 7. Home-to-school transportation and transportation between regular, full-time day schools and regional occupational centers, programs, or classes, as long as the fee does not exceed the statewide average nonsubsidized cost per student and exemptions are made for indigent and disabled students (Education Code 39805), the district provides a waiver based on financial need, and an exemption is made for any student with a disability whose individualized education program includes transportation as a related service necessary to receive a free appropriate public education (Education Code 39805)
- 8. Transportation for students to and from their places of employment in connection with any summer employment program for youth\_ (Education Code-\_39837)
- 9. Deposit for school band instruments, music, uniforms, and other regalia which school band members take on excursions to foreign countries\_ (Education Code-\_38120)
- 10. Sale or lease of personal computers or of Internet appliances that allow a person to connect to or access the district's educational network, provided that the items are sold or leased to parents/guardians at no more than cost and the district provides network access for families who cannot afford it\_ (Education Code\_17453.1)
- An adult education or secondary school community service class in civic, vocational, literacy, health, homemaking, and technical and general education, not to exceed the cost of maintaining the class\_ (Education Code-\_51810-51815)
- 12. Eye\_\_safety devices worn in courses or activities involving the use of hazardous substances likely to cause injury to the eyes, when being sold to students and/or teachers or instructors to keep and at a price not to exceed the district's actual costs (Education Code\_\_32033)

- 13. Actual-\_cost of furnishing copies of any student's records, except that no charge shall be made for furnishing up to two transcripts or two verifications of a former student's records or for reproducing records of a student with a disability when the cost would effectively prevent the parent/guardian from exercising the right to receive the copies (Education Code-\_49065,-\_56504)
- 14. Actual cost of duplication for reproduction of the prospectus of school curriculum or for copies of public records\_ (Education Code-\_49091.14; Government Code-\_6253)
- 15. Food sold at school, subject to free and reduced-price meal program eligibility and other restrictions specified in law\_ (Education Code\_38084)
- As allowed in In accordance with law, replacement cost or reimbursement for lost or willfully damaged district books, supplies, or property, or for district property loaned to a student that he/shethe student fails to return\_ (Education Code\_19910-19911,-48904)
- 17. Tuition for district school attendance by an out-of-state or out-of-country resident (Education Code-\_48050,-48052,-\_52613; 8 USC-\_1184)
- 18. Adult education books, materials, transportation, and classes, except that no fee may be charged for classes in elementary subjects, classes for which high school credit is granted when taken by a person who does not hold a high school diploma, or classes in English and citizenship\_ (Education Code\_39801.5,-52612,-60410)
- Preschool and child care and development services, in accordance with the fee schedule established by the Superintendent of Public Instruction, unless the family qualifies for subsidized services or the program is for severely disabled children and the student is eligible to enroll in itexempted from fees by law (Education Code-8239,-8250,-8263)
- 20. Participation in a before-school or after-school program that is funded as an After School Education and Safety (ASES) program, 21st Century Community Learning Center (21st CCLC), or 21st Century High School After School Safety and Enrichment for Teens program, provided that fees are waived or reduced for families with students who are eligible for free or reduced-price meals and, in regard to ASES and 21st CCLC programs, fees are not charged if the district knows the student is a homeless or foster youth\_ (Education Code-\_8422,-8482.6)
- 21. Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Diploma examinations for college credits, as long as the examination is not a course requirement and the results have no impact on student grades or credits in the course

## **Collection of Debt**

Before pursuing payment of any debt that has accumulated from unpaid permissible fees, the Superintendent or designee shall provide an itemized invoice for any amount owed by the parent/guardian on behalf of a student or former student. The invoice shall reference district policies related to debt collection and the rights established pursuant to Education Code 49014 and 49557.5. For each payment received, the district shall provide a receipt to the parent/guardian. (Education Code 49014)

The Superintendent or designee shall not sell debt owed by a parent/guardian of a student or former student. (Education Code 49014)Charge when When approved by the Governing Board, the Superintendent or designee may impose a fee for the following:\_ (5 CCR-\_350)
