<u>What service will be provided?</u>			
<p>Academic Solutions Group (ASG) will provide an academic improvement support program for Magnolia Elementary School. ASG will provide customized consulting services and related professional learning for administrators and staff focused on the school's Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) plan within its 2022-2023 School Plan (SPSA) and aligned with the district's LCAP and Academic Success Drivers. Areas of focus will include improving the effectiveness of Magnolia's professional learning communities and data-driven improvement cycles leading to improved academic achievement for students. ASG will concentrate the improvement focus on students who are English learners. ASG will provide other technical support needed for school improvement related to CSI and the Magnolia School Plan. Services will include comprehensive needs assessment, professional learning for staff, facilitation of PLC process, protocol design, data collection, individual and small group coaching and capacity building around using teacher collaboration to improve student outcomes.</p>			
<u>How will this service improve District/student outcomes?</u>			
<p>The technical assistance provided by Academic Solutions Group will support Magnolia Elementary School's work in implementing their School Plan and Comprehensive Support and Improvement requirements. Specifically, Magnolia Elementary School will refine their PLC process and improve classroom instruction which will result in improved academic learning outcomes for English learners and for all students.</p>			
<u>How will we know when the consultant's objective/s are met?</u>			
<p>-Magnolia Elementary students will show growth in academic achievement, data will be gathered from multiple sources (classroom diagnostic and formative assessments, school and district assessments, state test results, and shifts in the academic indicator on the California School Dashboard). -Site Administration, leadership, and consultant will co-develop a professional learning community improvement plan. This plan will be aligned to the Magnolia Elementary School Plan and District's LCAP. -Magnolia Elementary School will complete data-driven cycles of inquiry throughout the school year leading to instructional change and student academic growth. Post-cycle teacher feedback and measurements of PLC implementation will be collected. -Outcomes will also be measured through observations of instructional shifts by site leadership, the consultant, and staff.</p>
